I understand that I have been awarded an International Ambassador Scholarship to study abroad in a TnCIS/CBYX program next summer, subject to my compliance with the following requirements and to my acceptance into the TnCIS/CBYX program.

1. **From December to February** (before my trip) ~ I will assist the TnCIS/CBYX office in promoting study abroad programs and recruiting applicants from all DSCC locations.
2. I will serve as a volunteer at the **Spanish Feria** which takes place during spring break by assisting the Fair Organizational Committee in what they might need.
3.  I will either present my experiences to a minimum of two classes/college groups or  
 I will prepare a DVD that highlights my experiences and present this DVD to at least two classes/college groups.
4. **During the Study Abroad program** ~ I will serve as an international ambassador by assisting the Director in any way requested for the duration of the program. I will keep a daily journal of my experiences that details my activities and analyzes the differences between my culture and the one in which I am immersed. This journal will be reviewed by the Coordinator of International Studies at DSCC at the conclusion of my study abroad experience. I must turn it in to the DSCC Office of International Studies no later than one month after the date of my return.
5. I will provide DSCC three pictures of my trip and a quote to be used on the DSCC website for recruitment purposes.
6. **During the next Fall semester** (after my trip) ~ I will assist the DSCC International Studies Office in promoting study abroad programs and recruiting applicants from all DSCC campuses for TnCIS and the CBYX programs. This work will include being present at the Study Abroad Day at DSCC, taking part in panels and being interviewed by students/faculty/community. I understand that even if I am no longer a DSCC student, I will still be required to participate in this recruitment program.
7. **General** ~ At all times, I will maintain a positive and respectful attitude and conduct myself in a way that is appropriate for an International Ambassador of the college. (Program guidelines, policies and the DSCC Code of Conduct and Citizenship found on the back of this agreement).

## DSCC Code of Honor and Citizenship

### The Dyersburg State Code of Honor and Citizenship

When I enter Dyersburg State Community College, I agree to enter a community where people learn. I will:
