- It is also desirable but not essential for the candidate to be competent in the use of AutoCAD.
- Current driver's licence required.
- The candidate must hold an updated US passport.
- Good communication skills and team spirit approach
- The position is Atlanta based but the candidate must be willing to travel, often at short notice, throughout the US and overseas to carry out surveying or testing and / or supervise on-site floor construction of short and long-term projects up to 6 weeks.
- Opportunity to work in places such as United Kingdom, Europe, Australia, Dubai, Thailand and China. Your main focus will be in the United States.

- As well as carrying out specialist surveying and testing, the candidate is required to work with contractors and their workforce on flooring projects monitoring the construction process to ensure that construction tolerances and materials quality requirements are met.
