**Position Announcement:** The TBI Criminal Justice Academy is a one-week academy for college students. Students will experience hours of hands-on crime scene and professional development training. This academy focuses on career development for college students interested in the forensic science and criminal investigation fields. Students are housed and meals are provided at no cost. Applications are being accepted until April 17, 2017.

**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:** Must be a United States citizen who is at least 18 years old, Must be junior or senior status if receiving a four year degree or second year student if enrolled in a two year junior college, Must be recommended by a college/university faculty member to participate in the TBI Criminal Justice Academy, Criminal Justice students must have a 2.5 or higher cumulative grade point average (GPA) and students with Chemistry majors must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or above, Must pass an extensive background check.

***The following required documentation must be submitted to the TBI Training Division by all applicants:***

- 1) A resume
- 2) A 500 word essay on why the applicant wants to attend the TBI Criminal Justice Academy and how the Academy fits in his/her overall career plans.
- 3) A written recommendation letter from a college or university faculty member.
- 4) A certified copy of applicant's college or university transcripts.
