Process for Dual Credit

To receive DSCC dual credit, high school students must successfully complete a high school course that has been articulated with a DSCC course. Following completion of the articulated course, students must successfully complete a DSCC-prepared online examination in the College's eLearn platform in the subject area. Within two years of high school graduation, students must enroll at DSCC to receive the college credit for the articulated high school course. Credit will be awarded on the census date of the term the student enrolls.

Responsibilities of the student:

The Dual Credit process begins while the student is enrolled in high school and culminates after the student graduates from high school and enrolls at DSCC.

To apply for Dual Credit, a high school student must adhere to the following procedures:

1. The student will complete a high school course that aligns with a DSCC course.
2. The student will complete a free application to Dyersburg State Community College indicating dual credit.
3. The student will receive approval for the application of dual credit by obtaining signatures of the following:
 - Applicable high school instructor to verify eligibility to attempt exam
 - Applicable high school counselor to verify high school GPA
 - Parent or legal guardian
4. The student will bring the signed application to the testing location when attempting the dual credit exam (it is recommended that the student make a copy for their own records) and provide a school or government issued form of identification at the time of assessment.
5. The student will pay \$25.00 to receive DSCC college credit at the time of the exam.
6. The student should earn a minimum of 70% on the dual credit exam to receive credit.

Following high school graduation:

1. Within two years of high school graduation, the student should enroll as a degree-seeking student at DSCC. The student must be admitted to the College through the normal admission and registration processes.
2. After the census date, dual credit for the articulated course will be posted to the DSCC transcript.
