



TN Dual Enrollment Grant ▶ 2020-2021 Academic Year

Students receiving the Dual Enrollment Grant are eligible to receive a Dyersburg State Scholarship up to \$300 to cover the remaining costs of the 3rd grant-funded course. Students who do not use Dual Enrollment Grant funding will not receive a Dyersburg State Scholarship. Students are responsible for costs of course textbooks and materials.

The cost of tuition for dual enrollment students is \$166 per credit hour:

- 3 credit-hour course = \$498
- 4 credit-hour course = \$664

*Students participating in HOPE Borrowing can receive up to \$100 per credit hour.

Students are limited to a **maximum of 3 grants per semester.**

- In order to receive funding for the second and third courses during a semester, students must meet the minimum HOPE Scholarship academic requirements at the time of dual enrollment (**3.0 high school GPA or a composite score of at least 21 on the ACT**).
- Homeschool students must have a **composite score of at least 21** on the ACT to receive funding for the second course.
- If students enroll in two or more classes in a semester and wish to receive the second and third grant, they must electronically accept the Additional Courses Acknowledge Agreement when completing the online TN Dual Enrollment grant application.
- Students are responsible for any cost not covered by the TN Dual Enrollment Grant or HOPE Scholarship. The cost must be paid before the course begins.

After the first three TN Dual Enrollment Grants have been awarded (\$1,200), each subsequent grant award will deduct from the student's HOPE Scholarship.
