### **To transfer your benefits:**

Go through <https://www.benefits.va.gov/gibill/> using VONAPP

Fill out **Form 22-1995** – “Request for Change of Program or Place of Training”

### **To be eligible for Benefits at Dyersburg State, submit:**

Copy of your VA Form 22-1995 from VONAPP

Copy of your Certificate of Eligibility from the VA Copy of DD-214

### **To use VA Benefits towards your classes:**

Meet with your advisor to develop a plan towards graduation. In order for the VA to pay for your classes, you will need to designate a program of study that will lead to an Associate of Arts or Associate of Applied Science degree or eligible certificate listed in the Dyersburg State Community College catalog.

### **Register for classes:**

You will meet with an advisor to register for classes. You will register for classes during a designated orientation day OR a scheduled meeting with an advisor.
