Dual Enrollment



What is Dual Enrollment?

- Dual Enrollment programs allow high school students to take college classes while they are still in high school.
- You can earn college credit and high school credit at the same time for the same class.
- You can take classes at your high school (if available), at any of our locations, or online.



Why Dual Enroll?

- **Get a jump start on earning college credit!**
- **Dual Enrollment gives you college experience while you are still in high school.**
- **Dual Enrollment classes save you money.**



DSCC Admission Requirements

- **Must be a high school junior or senior.**
- **Must have at least a 3.00 cumulative high school GPA. An exception may be made at the recommendation of a high school official.**
- **Must have maintained a 2.0 college GPA if any previous college courses have been taken.**



How to Apply

1. Apply online at www.dsccl.edu/dualenrollment
2. Request for your guidance counselor to send your official high school transcript to DSCC.
3. Submit a copy of your ACT scores to DSCC at enroll@dsccl.edu.
4. Complete the online TN Dual Enrollment Grant Application at www.tn.gov/collegepays by the deadline.
 - September 15 – Fall Semester
 - February 1 – Spring Semester
 - May 15 – Summer Semester
