Student Release Form



The student will participate in the Partnership Enrollment Program between the partner Community College and the University of Memphis beginning the semester prior to earning no more than 30 hours of college-level university track coursework.

To be eligible for the Partnership Enrollment Program, the student must meet the following requirements:

- Complete Partnership Enrollment Program Intent to Enroll Form prior to completing no more than 30 semester credit hours of college-level university track coursework
- 2. Complete an Associate's degree university track (AA/AS)
- 3. Must be in academic and financial good standing at the partner Community College

As a Partnership Enrollment Program student, the student is entitled to receive the following services from the University of Memphis:

- Guaranteed admission to the U of M while you are completing your associate degree, provided you comply with requirements.
- Priority pre-registration in University courses for your first semester after graduation.
- Access to academic advising and degree plans from both the partner Community College and U of M advisors throughout your tenure in the program.
- Admission fee waiver
- Access to U of M facilities and services such as the library and Art Museum.
- Access to Student Affairs and Athletics prior to full admission
- A Community College student who is 'co-admitted' to the U o M under the Partnership Enrollment Program may opt to purchase:

1. Access to a Parking Permit

\$30.00 per semester

2. Access to Campus Recreation & Intramural Services + Student Activities

\$65/semester AND/OR

3. Access to Student Athletic events via payment of FT Student Athletics Fee

\$225/semester

The following conditions apply:

- 1. The student's enrollment at the University of Memphis is governed by the terms and provisions of the Memphis Catalog in effect at the semester of transfer or semester of acceptance of application.
- 2. Student must maintain enrollment for this agreement to remain in effect. If a student fails to enroll at the partner Community College and attain a university track AA/AS degree, then the student will be required to submit a U of M Partnership Enrollment Admissions Form to the U of M Office of Admissions and will be subject to the U of M university catalog at the time of application and enrollment.
- 3. Student will request an official copy of the high school record. If your high school graduation is through the General Education Development (GED) program, have these scores forwarded to the office. You must submit scores earned on the ACT or SAT examination for consideration. Entrance examination scores cannot be more than three years old at the time of enrollment.
- 4. Student will request an official copy of the academic record from each college or university in which you have enrolled.
- 5. Complete the Partnership Enrollment Program Admission Form

Deadlines for submitting the Partnership Enrollment Form:	Fall	Spring	Summer
Domestic Applicants:	July 1	December 1	May 1
International Applicants:	May 1	September 15	February 1

- 6. Do not attend another institution between the time you graduate and formally enroll at the University of Memphis.
- 7. Student will be eligible for acceptance to general degree programs once a university track AA/AS degree is granted, but certain degree programs will require additional admissions requirements.
- 8. Student will comply with the U of M advising requirements.
- 9. The Student Affairs and Athletics fees would be tied to equivalent Program Services Fees paid by U of M students and would change accordingly; revenues would accrue as if paid by U of M students.
- 10. The PEP student can purchase from the Parking Office what is referred to as a "Continuing Education" parking permit at \$30 per semester to allow them access to all general parking lots.
- 11. Student is subject to the academic and disciplinary policies of the enrolling institution. Additionally, student is subject to policies governing student use of career counseling, and library when using those services.
- 12. Student understands that loss of eligibility to continue in classes at the partner Community College may cause termination of this agreement.
- 13. Student may cancel this agreement at any time upon written notice to the partner Community College office of Admissions.

By signing this agreement, the student authorizes the partner Community College and the University of Memphis to exchange all information on a regular basis related to the student's enrollment at either institution for purposes of maintaining academic, discipline and other appropriate student records as required to be maintained by each institution, and asserts that he/she will meet Partnership Enrollment Program requirements as outlined above.

I understand that signatures below from the partner Community College and University of Memphis only acknowledge receipt of this agreement. This agreement is not official until verification is made by the partner Community College and the University of Memphis that the student meets the Partnership Enrollment Program requirements.
