- 2. If you are requesting financial aid (including scholarships), you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The Priority Date for financial aid & scholarships is March 1. Priority consideration will be given to those who complete the FAFSA and meet all other requirements by this date. You can apply online at www.FAFSA.ed.gov. To receive financial aid, you must be degree-seeking and must have completed all requirements for admission to the College. - 3. DSCC is offering a variety of academic programs which lead to certificates and degrees. Refer to page 2 for information regarding degrees, majors, areas of emphasis, concentrations and certificates.
