Graduates Success on the licensure examination

The annual NCLEX-RN pass rate for first-time test takers will be at or above eighty percent (80%) in accordance with the accreditation and state requirements.

Program Completion

Traditional: Forty-five percent (45%) of all students who begin in the first NRSG course in the traditional program option will complete the AAS in four academic semesters.

LPN/Paramedic to RN Pathway: Forty-five percent (45%) of all students who begin in the first NRSG course in the pathway will complete the AAS in three academic semesters.
